

MEDIA INFORMATION NEWSLETTER

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The European Handball Federation ("EHF", "We", "Our", "Us") owns and operates the domain website www.eurohandball.com and the EHF applications relevant to EHF.tv, and EHF's club or national team competitions ("EHF website(s)"), including all digital content and functionality contained on them, non-excluding direct contact tools such as newsletters, media channels, social media accounts, and others used to communicate with EHF's target audience under determined purposes hereinunder (together the "EHF Platforms"). Your access and direct updates to and concerning the tool hereinunder described and which terms are herein best comprised, are subject to the following terms and conditions and any documents referred to in them (the "Terms & Conditions").

Informative and explanatory material relating to the Media information Newsletter and any further updates, changes, or alterations made at any point to the present, published on EHF platforms under any format, shall form an integral part of these Terms & Conditions.

1) Online informative tools promoter

2) General Information and Acceptance of Terms

The EHF's media department has developed an online informative tool aimed at providing exclusive inside information on all EHF competitions to media channels, on a competition individual demand and consent basis.

When accessing and using a EHF Platform and/or any specific content or material contained in it, additional guidelines or rules may apply which are relevant to (and communicated on or within) the EHF Platform (in addition to any supplemental provisions that may be incorporated in these Terms & Conditions). To the extent that there may be any inconsistency between these Terms & Conditions and any such guidelines or rules, the guidelines or rules shall prevail.

3) Subscription and Registration

3.1. Certain covenants of the EHF Platforms require registration and/or subscription to access all relevant content and/or functionality ("Restricted Access Areas"). By registering, you represent that: (i) you are eligible for an account (by reference to the eligibility criteria included in paragraph 3.2. below); and (ii) the information you include about yourself (as part of the registration process) (your "Personal Data") is true, accurate, current and complete (and you undertake to maintain such Personal Information during the time you have a EHF account).

3.2. You are only eligible to register for a EHF Media information Newsletter subscription if: (i) you are an individual who is at least eighteen (18) years old or of legal age in your country of residence if such age exceeds eighteen (18); and (ii) if you are an individual holding official media credentials from a reputable or otherwise know Media information in connection to EHF, and have, are, or will cover EHF competitions on a professional reporting basis.

3.3. If you provide, or if EHF has reasonable grounds to suspect that you have provided, any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current, or incomplete, EHF reserves the right to suspend or terminate your subscription and refuse you access to any and all EHF Platform.

3.4. Subscription to our newsletter is free of charge. You may subscribe by submitting your personal data as requested under the labeled fields on a form to be attached to invitation email. Subscription to the Newsletter is limited to persons holding Media platform credentials in any terms applicable, and its invitations shall be sent solely to those contained in EHF's competitions' credentials platform under media contacts, whose personal data has been collected and processed accordingly including the purposes concerned herein.

4) Registration through third-party authentication service

In the event that you are required to subscribe to the Newsletter through a third-party authentication service (including, but not limited to *Typeform*), EHF shall receive your input information, whatever its nature of category, but you shall remain responsible for: (i) ensuring your compliance with Article 3.1 above; and (ii) the terms relevant to your relationship with such third-party authentication provider (including any relevant consents you may provide within the any platforms not owned by EHF, with respect to your Personal Data).

In the event of early termination with or modification of your consents as initially given to such third-party authentication service provider, EHF may be required to delete certain data as referred to you, which could implicate the operation as established between you and EHF in connection to the Newsletter. In such circumstances, you are hereby advised to review and update, where necessary, your Personal Data to ensure that there is no unexpected interruption to your subscription of the Newsletter. Should you alter your personal data, related consent to the activities herein described, or take any other action, which might directly impact or be reasonably presumed to impact the preservation of your subscription, or refer form taking any actions as communicated, which might implicate a lack of consent and implicitly your access to the Newsletter, EHF is hereby exempt from any responsibility in connection to such breakage.

5) Intellectual Property Rights

All intellectual property rights contained and/or referenced in our Newsletter, including but not limited to all content, design, trademarks, copywriting, are owned by EHF. You hereby agree not to copy, reproduce, or distribute any part of the Newsletter without our prior documented consent. The Newsletter shall include exclusive information pertaining to EHF competitions based off

individual competition consent access, including news, events inside scoop, promotions, and other updates at EHF's sole discretion. We reserve the right to change or modify the content of the Newsletter at any time without prior notice or further consent on your behalf.

6) Consent to the Terms & Conditions

The EHF is the sole controller and processor of the data processed, in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

EHF's Media information Newsletter (the "Newsletter") requires the collection of personal data for the sole purposes referred hereinto and specifically to the data use described in these T&Cs, and such data shall not be shared with any third parties to EHF.

By subscribing to our Media information Newsletter, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. To the fullest extent permitted by law, EHF shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or exemplary damages arising out of or in connection with the use of our Newsletter or any content contained therein.

7) Limitation of Liability

The EHF shall not be liable for faults caused by circumstances outside of their control. This applies particularly to impairments resulting from the failure of or interruptions to the telephone communication network or power supply.

Furthermore, the EHF makes no warrantee or guarantee of any kind (including liability towards third parties), neither expressed nor implied, as to the permanent accuracy, reliability or completeness of the information and available content and services, including, but not limited to:

- The functionality of any and all informative tools;
- Costs incurred by data roaming.

Legal recourse in connection with informative newsletters is hereby excluded. The present T&Cs comply in full with the applicable Laws as provided for by the Government of Austria and all European applicable acts, accordingly.

WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE USER AGREES TO BE BOUND TO THESE T&CS, WHICH SHALL CONSTITUTE A CONTRACTUAL BOND ON DATA COLLECTION; THIS CONTRACT INCLUDES INDEMNITIES TO PROMOTION ENTITIES ON YOUR BEHALF AND A LIMITATION OF YOUR RIGHTS AND REMEDIES.

8) Data Privacy

The registration as receptor of the Newsletter requires the input of first and last names, email address, date of birth, workplace, and job title therein, and country of residence (the Personal

Data). The Personal Data collected and processed during your access to our Platforms will be processed EHF in accordance with GDPR and with the applicable Austrian privacy and data protection laws. The Personal Data collected by EHF will be processed and used in all circumstances for informative purposes.

Furthermore, all personally identifiable information provided during the subscription process will be treated in accordance with the privacy policies posted on our website.

Users may revoke their consent at any time and without providing reasons, with effect for the future. If you revoke your consent to the processing of data, you are no longer entitled to receive updates or any further communications as related to the Newsletter herein contained, described or mentioned. You shall maintain access to prior communications as received in your email inbox. In order to revoke your consent, please send an email to dpo@eurohandball.com. We may have to ask you for appropriate identification, depending on the type of data we have stored from you up to receiving your request.
